2. Click on the **Download Now** button
3. If you have not already signed into [www.comcast.net](http://www.comcast.net) with your Comcast username and password, you will be asked to sign in now. [Click here](#) to chat with a Comcast representative if you do not know your Comcast username and password
4. Accept the McAfee User License Agreement. This will trigger the McAfee Download Manager.
